## Frequently Asked Questions (FAQs)

Clinic Set-Up		
	Question	Answer
1	Appointment Reasons - Are the 'Add/Remove/Edit' settings specific to a provider or are they clinic specific?	The 'Add' feature is provider specific. The 'Remove/Edit' features depend on whether it is a 'system default' reason or a 'provider specific' reason.
2	Patient Self-Booking - Is this feature available? If so, is it provider specific or clinic specific?	The patient self-scheduling feature is disabled at this time. If enabled, it is a clinic-wide feature.
3	As a clinical user, do I need to install an app on my desktop to use this platform?	No, the platform works on a dedicated webapp. After taking the following steps on a laptop/desktop, access the platform on the web at <a href="https://virtualvisit.saskatchewan.ca/">https://virtualvisit.saskatchewan.ca/</a> or you <u>may</u> download the 'SK Virtual Visit' app, which contains <u>limited</u> features only: <ol style="list-style-type: none"><li>1. request a SK Virtual Visit account,</li><li>2. be invited by email to join a virtual clinic,</li><li>3. create their account, and</li><li>4. join the virtual clinic they are invited to</li></ol>
Inviting Patients		
	Question	Answer
4	If two patients share an e-mail address (e.g., spousal account), can they both be invited to a clinic using that same e-mail?	E-mail addresses are unique account log-in identifiers; therefore, each user will need to use a unique e-mail address to create and log into their account. This also protects the privacy of all individuals' healthcare records and medical history.
5	Will the system catch duplicate e-mail addresses?	The system will only allow for one user to create their account using a shared email address. If a second user tries to create their account with an email address that has already been taken, they will receive an error message.
6	If the patient does not have an e-mail address or phone number, are they still able to be invited to create a SK Virtual Visit account and join a virtual clinic?	For a patient to create an account and join a virtual clinic, they do require an email address.



		<p>If they do not have an email address, do not wish to create an email address or simply do not want to create a SK Virtual Visit account, they can still be seen virtually by a healthcare provider using the SK Virtual Visit video meeting feature.</p> <p>They would be invited by email to attend a video meeting with a unique meeting hyperlink, ID and passcode.</p>
	<p>If the clinic does not have a patient’s e-mail address or mobile phone number, is it still possible for the clinic to invite their patient to create a SK Virtual Visit account and join their virtual clinic?</p> <p>Is there a printable handout with the invite code to provide the patient, if they happen to be physically in the clinic?</p>	<p>An invite code is generated with ALL clinic invites, regardless of whether an email address/ mobile number are entered or not.</p> <p>The patient can be given this invite code to join your virtual clinic.</p> <p>There is not a printable feature within the platform at this time, however the clinic can create a printable handout that includes the patient’s invite code, if they wish.</p>
7	Does the invite code remain active until it is used, or does it expire?	It expires after 30 days.
8	If resending an invitation to a patient to join a virtual clinic, is a new invite code generated?	<p>If ‘Resend Invite’ is clicked from the list under ‘Invited Patients’, a new invite code is not generated.</p> <p>If the invitation under ‘Invited Patients’ is ‘Removed’ or expires and the patient is re-invited under the ‘Invite Patients’ section, a new invite code is generated.</p>
<b>Patient Consultations / Video Meetings</b>		
	<b>Question</b>	<b>Answer</b>
9	During a video meeting session, will attendees be notified when someone else joins?	<p>The meeting host is notified when someone else attempts to join a video meeting; the host will have the option to accept or decline them admission.</p> <p>Note: All participants in a video meeting can see all others who are in the meeting (under the ‘Participants’ button).</p>
10	Are participants immediately admitted into a video meeting or do they have to wait to be admitted?	For security purposes, participants from outside the host’s virtual clinic are unable



		<p>to enter a video meeting unless the host admits them.</p> <p>If they are declined entry or removed from a video meeting, they will receive a message, 'Admission Declined' and will be unable to join.</p> <p>Invited care team members from the host's virtual clinic will automatically join.</p>
11	<p>What is displayed when patients are contacted through the platform by phone?</p> <p>Are patients able to call back if disconnected?</p>	<p>They will see a 1-833 number displayed when being called.</p> <p>There is no callback feature available, however, the physician can initiate the call again from their end.</p>
12	Can we set consultations to low bandwidth?	No, the application is designed to automatically scale to the available bandwidth.
<b>Scheduling</b>		
	<b>Question</b>	<b>Answer</b>
13	If patient self-scheduling was enabled for my clinic and a patient cancels their appointment, would I be notified?	<p>Yes. You can be notified via e-mail and/or SMS text message.</p> <p>These preferences can be managed under Account --&gt; Notifications</p>
14	Can multiple appointments be scheduled at one time for a patient, ie monthly, bi-weekly, etc.?	Appointment occurrences available are No Repeat (one time), Daily, Weekly, Monthly, Yearly & Custom
15	If the patient and provider agree to meet earlier, does the appointment show at the original time?	Yes, it still shows at the original time. You would then have to cancel the meeting in the schedule so that time becomes available for another appointment.
16	If patient self-booking is turned off, do you still have to enter the clinician shifts?	No. Patient consultations and meetings can be scheduled without having a clinician's shift entered, by selecting 'Specific Time' on the 'Schedule Appointment' screen.

	Question	Answer
17	What is the difference between video meetings and patient consultations.	SK Virtual Visit offers both ways of seeing patients virtually. 18	Can we add a ‘Print PDF’ option for screens, such as Patient Info and Appointment Info?	Yes, it can be built, but must be requested and approved through eHealth & your Health Service Provider first. Note: There are privacy considerations with this feature.
19	What is the timing for codes to expire within the system?	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Video meeting invite codes expire at the end of the call, such as when the video meeting host clicks ‘End Call for All’ or everyone leaves and no one returns after approx. 20 minutes</li><li>• Invite codes for adding additional participant(s) to a consult expire after approximately 11 days</li><li>• Invite user to clinic codes expire after approximately 30 days</li></ul>
20	Is there an ability to add dependents within the platform?	The dependent’s feature within the application had to be removed as there were privacy and security concerns. Depending on the clinic’s protocol, dependents may have their own account created by their guardian, be seen under their parent’s account or be seen via a video meeting where an account is not required.
21	What is the technology used in the backend for the video consultations?	WebRTC, with Daily’s Canadian Data Center as the video provider.
22	Many of our staff have older computers; what technology is needed/used?	Technical Requirements can be found in these articles – click the links:

23	What is the purpose of the 3-hour window between when a clinician archives a consultation and when it gets archived?	<p>This allows time for the clinician or their admin to go back into the consultation, and add notes or perform other necessary actions.</p> <p>In addition, during this 3-hour window, patients are able to come back and ask questions.</p>
24	Is Archiving a patient consultation the same as closing a video meeting?	<p>Yes, archiving a consultation is the same as when a video meeting host selects 'End Call for All'.</p>
25	Can the 'Feedback' feature be customized?	<p>No, this is a standard feature, however it is currently disabled.</p>
26	Can multiple participants be dialed into a 'Phone Meeting'?	<p>No, this workflow is for a 1-on-1 phone call.</p> <p>However, once in a 'Video Meeting', a host can 'Dial in' multiple participants by phone. Those participants would only have audio and no video.</p>
27	Can someone call into a video chat with a phone?	<p>No, to join a video chat by phone, a participant must be dialed in by the meeting host after the video meeting has started.</p>
28	Can a participant on the video call dial in someone to join the video call?	<p>Only the meeting host can 'Dial In' another participant by phone. The host can do this on behalf of another participant.</p>
29	Can patient information be changed by the clinician or admin?	<p>No, only the patient can change their account info.</p>
